What we do

OS Domains operates European email infrastructure on owned bare-metal across 7 points of presence (5 in the EU, plus Dallas USA and Panama City). Our customers — about 380 active accounts — span B2B SaaS, banking and fintech, e-commerce, and EU public-sector entities. We are EU-incorporated (Austria), EU-routed by default, and operationally independent: no venture-capital funding, no shared infrastructure with hyperscalers, no per-message pricing games. The platform handles transactional email at sub-2-second median latency, marketing sends at 5M messages per hour per PoP, and cold-outbound workloads with up to 200 sending domains per account under our Acceptable Use Policy.

Why journalists cover us

OS Domains is a credible counter-example to the dominant narrative of European tech as a venture-backed sector chasing US trajectories. We have been profitable for 12 years, bootstrapped throughout, and grew by hiring 3-5 people per year. Our customer base illustrates concrete EU sovereignty demand: 11 financial-sector customers across 8 Member States operate under DORA-compatible contracts; 8 EU public-sector entities have selected us in open procurement under directive 2014/24/EU. For Schrems II, we maintain four active Transfer Impact Assessments and offer EU-only routing as a default on Enterprise.
